## Additional Information

- 1. This application must be completed fully and legibly, and accompanied by all required items listed with in the Submittal Requirements Checklist.
- 2. Only persons having a proprietary interest in the subject property may file an application. If signed by an agent of the owner, the application shall be accompanied by a written, instrument, executed by the person with proprietary interest under oath, establishing the agent or agency. If title is in a Land Trust, the application must be filed by the Trustee.
- 3. All items of information requested on this application form must be provided prior to processing of the application. PLEASE ALLOW 3 TO 5 BUSINESS DAYS FOR PROCESSING OF APPLICATION. **INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL BE RETURNED FOR PROCESSING.**
- 4. The completed application, items of information and other required submittals shall be filed with the Jersey County Code Administrator Office and the permit fee shall be paid at the time of application. The application fee is non-refundable even if the requested demolition is subsequently withdrawn.
- 5. It is the responsibility of the applicant to arrange for all utilities and septic system to be disconnected. Gas, electric, telephone, or cable services shall be disconnected by the company providing the service. Written proof of disconnection shall be provided as part of the demolition permit application. Please be advised that your permit will not be issued until all utility services have been disconnected and the septic capped.
- 6. For commercial or public buildings the demolition contractor must provide a copy of Certificate of Insurance in the amount of \$100,000 or more for property damage and at least \$200,000 for personal injury and Proof of Liability Insurance naming the county as loss payee.
- 7. It is the responsibility of the demo contractor to contact J.U.L.I.E. (800-892-0123) for utility locations as well as local phone, cable providers etc. to ensure proper disconnects have been completed.
- 8. If structure is located in a floodplain the demo contractor must follow all Federal, State, and local regulations.
- 9. Copies of receipts for roll-offs must be presented prior to obtaining a permit. Burning and open dumping of construction and demolition debris is strictly prohibited by the Environmental Protection Act. http://www.epa.illinois.gov/topics/forms/air-permits/open-burning/
